We take turns playing.
At your turn, pick a card and read it aloud

2

When the Instruction Cards are completed, we continue in turn with the Question Cards.

3

Read each card aloud and answer the question asked.

4

Other players can ask you questions or make suggestions. But they can't answer for you and it's up to you to decide whether or not to take them into account

5

If there is a card, or an answer, that you do not want to include in the story, touch the X card. This content is removed from the game

6

Your turn, you can pass. "Give" your card to the next player and say, "I'd like to hear your answer to that question."

7

A Question card can thus be passed from player to player until it is cancelled by card X.

8

Continue to answer, pass or use the X card until the Final Card is drawn.

9

Each player answers the Final Question in turn. Then the game is over

Here is the initial situation:

A few weeks ago, the Zombie Apocalypse hit the world.

12

A large part of humanity has turned into a horde of cannibal zombies.

13

Chaos reigns. The government can no longer control the situation.

14

Apart from hordes of hungry zombies, looting, murder and general suspicions are spreading.

15

You are one of the few survivors, a group of nine people on their way to Atlanta.

16

Each player plays one of the members of the group.

17

Rumours are that the situation would be better in Atlanta.

18

So you hope to find a refuge or an evacuation zone or even a cure for the "disease".

19

Your convoy includes cars and trucks, food and weapons and a strong faith in the future.

20

But will your solidarity survive the dangers that lie ahead?

The player who wishes to can now draw the first Question Card and answer it.

You have lost a loved one. How? How?

You're lying about your past. What do you have to hide?

Who did you change your mind about and why?

Who you don't trust
and why?

You are woken up at
night by a noise.
What's going on?
What's going on?

You were a member of
another group
previously. Why did
you leave him?

You know a secret.
Which one and about
whom?

What resource are
you missing? What is
the long-term risk?

Who knows a secret
about you? What risk
if he reveals it?

You know where to
find a vital resource.
Which one? Do you
share information and
with whom?

You have to convince
someone to act
against their
principles. Who and
why?

You have to choose
between two routes.
The group is divided.
Why? Why?

Somebody's lying.
Who and how do you
know that?

Who seems
psychologically
unstable to you? What
are you going to do
about it?

You know something
about imminent
danger. What do you
know?

You heard a conversation behind the scenes. What was it about?

You have a resource that you have never mentioned to others. Which one?

Someone is endangering the group by their behaviour. What are you going to do about it?

You know that something is a source of hope. What is it about?

Two people have a relationship that they hide from others. Who? Who? What relationship?

You recognized someone who presents himself under a false identity. Who? Who?

You heard rumors about the situation in Atlanta. What rumors?

Who do you fully trust and why?

Someone opposes you and refuses to compromise. Who and why?

What were you doing before the Apocalypse?

What object do you want and why? How far are you willing to go to get it?

What changed in your personality after the Apocalypse? How does this manifest itself?

You committed horrible acts to survive. Which ones?

You owe someone a debt to someone. Who and why?

What is the weak point of your convoy?

Do you think you'll find relatives alive. If so, who?

Do you believe what they say about Atlanta? If not, why not?

What did you find in the forest?

Why do you want to go to Atlanta?

Who is ungrateful to you and why?

Who seems infected to you and why? Are you entrusting your suspicions to someone?

You've spotted signs of a threat. Which ones?

You know useful things about the places you're going through. What? What?

Who are these people in the picture you always carry with you?

Who annoys you in the group and why?

What is your main quality?

Who do you think is the weakest link in the group and why?

Who do you think is endangering the convoy and why?

What is your biggest flaw?

Which personal object are you very dear to and why don't you want to part with it?

A person admires you but you don't like him. Who? Who? Why? Why?

Who saved your life? Are you grateful to him/her?

You lose a member of the convoy at the beginning of the trip. How? How? Who do you hold responsible?

Do you think the group needs a leader? Who could play this role?

There is a conflict between two members. Do you know why?

You have helped the group in a decisive way. By doing what?
